## Wilson Appoints New Staff

### *Announces Chief of Staff, Communications Officer*

(Fort Worth, TX) — Tarrant County Criminal District Attorney Sharen Wilson announced two additions to her senior staff today.

Shannon Fletcher will serve as Wilson's Chief of Staff, responsible for the management of all non-attorney, non-investigator staff. Fletcher joins Wilson's team from the office of Tarrant County Commissioner Roy Brooks, where she has served as Executive Administrator for Policy, Programs and Outreach since February 2013. Her prior experience includes tenure as Executive Director of the Generation Hope Laptop Program and Public Affairs Director for the National Multiple Sclerosis Society. She holds an Executive MBA from TCU's Neeley School of Business, and a BA in Government from The University of Texas at Austin.

Sam Jordan is Wilson's new Communications Officer. In addition to serving as spokesperson for the Criminal District Attorney's office, Jordan will provide strategic direction for both internal and external communications goals and operations, serving as a liaison to the media, public and other governmental entities. Jordan has experience with both global and boutique public affairs agencies, and previously spent a decade on the staff of U.S. Representative Joe Barton, including serving as Press Secretary for the U.S. House Committee on Energy & Commerce during his tenure as Chairman. She has a BA in History from Texas A&M University.

Both women will be located on the 4th floor of the Tim Curry Criminal Justice Center. Shannon Fletcher will officially join the staff on Monday, April 6; Sam Jordan started on March 31.
