Statement re: Today's Actual Innocence Exoneration of John Nolley

- "As prosecutors, it is our sworn duty to get it right. And when we discover that errors have been made, it is our responsibility to make it right.
- "We cannot change the past. But we are committed to learning from it, so we can ensure that errors are never repeated.
- "John Nolley's legacy to the criminal justice system will live on through the legislation his case inspired, ensuring no person should have to defend himself against unsubstantiated, unreliable jailhouse testimony.
- "We also want to commend Bedford Police Chief Gibson and his officers for the way in which they embraced this process. Their actions should serve as a model for law enforcement, and we are confident they will continue to diligently investigate the suspects in this case."
