## Tarrant County ACDA named to Texas County and District Retirement System Board of Trustees

(Fort Worth, TX) – Christopher “Chris” Taylor, an Assistant Criminal District Attorney in the Office of Tarrant County Criminal District Attorney Sharen Wilson, has been appointed by Gov. Greg Abbott to serve on the Texas County and District Retirement System Board of Trustees.

Taylor, who works in the civil division, this week was named – along with Fannin County Clerk Tammy Biggar and Harris County Justice of the Peace Holly Williamson – to serve a term that expires December 31, 2025.

“I am pleased Gov. Abbott recognized the work ethic and achievements of Chris,” Sharen Wilson said. “Chris will do a wonderful job serving in this position.”

The board oversees the retirement system for employees and retirees of more than 780 counties and districts.
