Indictments issued in Mother's Day shooting at Village Creek Park

(Fort Worth, TX) - Six men have been indicted on charges of engaging in organized criminal activity tied to a May 10, 2020, shooting at Village Creek Park in Fort Worth.

A Tarrant County Grand Jury handed up indictments Wednesday for Curtis Dwayne Goss, 22; Kristopher Robinzine, 26; Caleb Lorenzo Houston, 20; Dcameron Lajuan McKellar, 21; Daveon Harden, 19; and Avin Wilburn, 19.

All were indicted on the same charges: three counts of engaging in organized crime; three counts of aggravated assault; and two counts of engaging in organized crime, deadly conduct.

"Our investigation is ongoing and we are not ruling out the possibility of charging others," said Page Simpson, chief of the gang unit in the Tarrant County Criminal District Attorney's Office.
