Indictment issued in 2019 Arlington Police shooting

(Fort Worth, TX) - A Tarrant County Grand Jury returned an indictment Wednesday related to the Aug. 1, 2019, shooting death of Margarita Brooks.

Former Arlington Police Officer Ravinder Singh was indicted on a charge of criminally negligent homicide.

A person is criminally negligent with respect to the result of his or her conduct when he or she ought to be aware of a substantial and unjustifiable risk that a particular result will occur. A person commits criminally negligent homicide when he or she causes the death of another person by criminal negligence.

Criminally negligent homicide is a state jail felony punishable by 180 days to two years in state jail and a fine of up to \$10,000.
