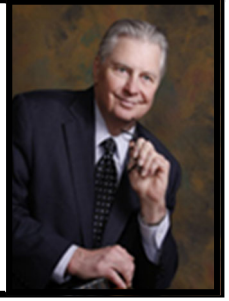

Change Regarding Notices of Dismissal and Trial Dockets Effective July 1, 2019

Dear Attorneys,

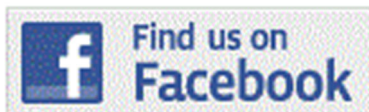
I am writing to notify you of a new change being implemented and **effective July 1, 2019**. My office will begin sending both the Notices of Dismissal (DWOP) and Trial Dockets **via e-mail**. The case number will be referenced in the subject line and the appropriate notice will be attached. Please see the [DC Facebook page](#) for examples of the e-mails.

This new process will allow us to save costs in both paper and postage, as well as provide you and the judges with information more efficiently. Please make sure your e-mail address that is required by the e-filing rules is up-to-date as that is the e-mail address we will use to send the DWOP Notices to you. The Order of Dismissal will continue to be sent by USPS as required by statute.

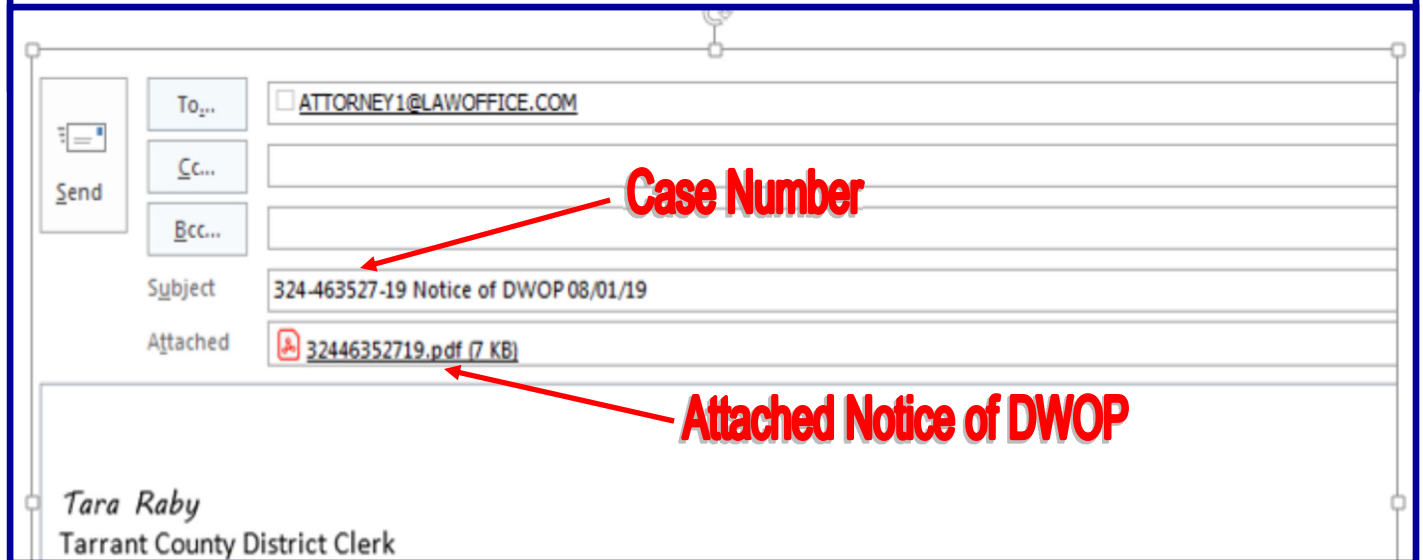

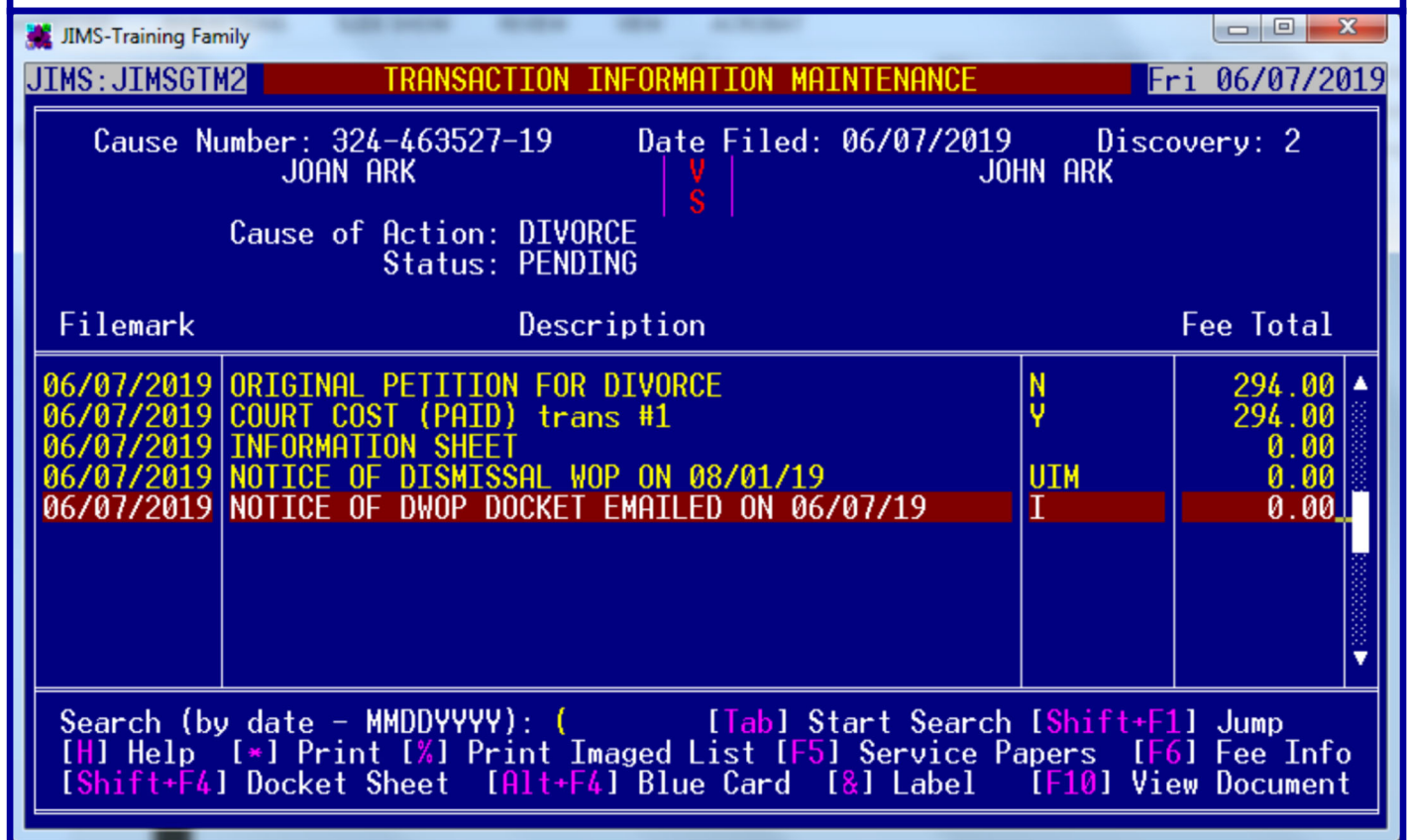

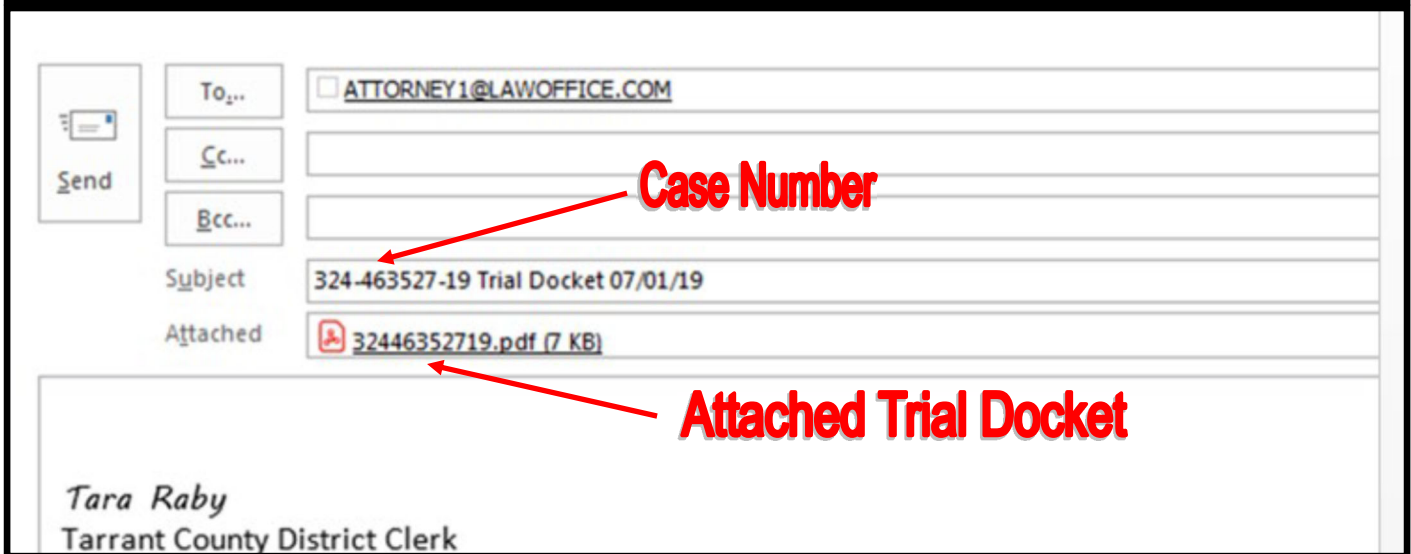
Example of e-mail sent to active attorneys of Notice of DWOP
