DISTRICT CLERK CORNER

Dear Legal Professionals:

Here are some thoughts and comments about current issues facing our office that I hope you will take into consideration.

1. With the 3.5% cap on tax revenue placed on counties and cities in the last session of the Texas Legislature, I may not be able to keep the same level of service that we have been able to deliver over the years. We will wait and see how this plays out in the coming year but with record increases in case filings 3 years running and a very tight job market, it will be tough.
2. Almost 71,000 cases were filed through our office in to the district courts in FY 2019, which just ended (see page 6). In just 3 years, we have jumped from 60,000 cases to 71,000 new cases filed. This does not include subsequent filings after a new case is filed.
3. Employee turnover has averaged over 20% each of the last three years even though Commissioner's Court has given me new resources including extra money for deputies again this year. The tight job market is the toughest I have seen in 25 years. That's why you are seeing so many new faces. Training all these new people is a real challenge for my managers.
4. We deploy overtime money and cross trained employees plus part-time people into courts that have surges and backed up work, but my resources are finite, and we are doing the best we can.
5. New initiatives under discussion at the JCIT/Supreme Court include Juvenile e-filing as well as requiring initial case filing to

be e-filed by the District Attorney instead of just subsequent filings as it is now. These will be big changes for both of us.

6. The new juvenile building kick-off has been slowed by very high bids that were budget busters. New bids were sought along with some cost cutting which hopefully will allow construction to start soon.

Finally, while these observations are causing some sleepless nights for me and my deputies, I recognize that we are being paid to figure all this out and make it fit the needs of the taxpayer and the rule of law.

When reviewing e-filing documents and determining the filing must be returned to the filer, the clerk will select the appropriate reason based on the list provided in the JCIT Standards as shown below. The clerk will include a detailed message in the “Reject Comment” box, as well as their name, phone number and e-mail address in the event you need to contact the clerk.

Once an envelope has been corrected and re-filed the District Clerk’s office will accept the corrected envelope with the new date/time filed. The pleading will not be backdated to the date of the returned envelope.
