- Proof of need to drive. Examples of proof: A letter from your employer or immediate supervisor on your employer's letterhead (or an affidavit) that verifies your work schedule, a current pay stub, school registration with schedule, or your sworn affidavit explaining to the court why you need to drive unless your license is solely based on an intoxication offense under Penal Code 49.04-49.08 and any vehicle you own or operate must be equipped with an interlock device.
