### **Overview**

Generally, fraud is the "knowing misrepresentation or knowing concealment of a material fact made to induce another to act to his or her detriment. Fraud is usually a tort, but in some cases (especially when the conduct is willful) it may be a crime." Black's Law Dictionary, 11th ed.
