




Women, Non-Hispanic Blacks, and Youth

The consequences of an STD are more serious for a pregnant woman and her baby. Due in part to interventions targeted toward this population, the number of pregnant women diagnosed with STDs in Tarrant County decreased 15% from 2009 to 2012.
