





HIV/AIDS IN TARRANT COUNTY, 2008-2012











Overall, the rate of new HIV/AIDS cases decreased 15% from 2008 to 2012. However, the rate increased 36% among residents aged 15 to 24 years and increased 12% among non-Hispanic black men.
