Emergencies and disasters can strike quickly and without warning. Residents in Tarrant County have faced floods, fires and tornados that have caused extensive damage and loss of life in recent years. What would you do if your basic services - water, gas, electricity or communications - were cut off? In an emergency, local officials and relief workers will not be able to reach everyone right away. Learn how to protect yourself and cope with disaster by planning ahead. You can deal with disaster better by preparing in advance and by working with those in your support network: your family, neighbors and friends as a team. Being prepared is your responsibility.
